

Thirteen years ago Prof. George Vithoulkas gave a lecture in the Aegean University, Greece during the first year of Master of Science in Classical Homeopathy.

In his opening lecture, he spoke about an idea he has long cherished in his mind that was totally revolutionary, not only for homoeopathy but for medicine in general.

He said that there is a "Continuum" in the pathology of patients that may start from the first pathologies, after birth, that eventually form a chain of pathological conditions right through life.

He named his idea "The Continuum of a Unified Theory of Diseases", published in the medical peer reviewed journal "Science Medical Monitor" https://www.medscimonit.com/download/index/idArt/878341

A German publisher had a brilliant idea for a book where children could ask questions and Nobel Laureates give answers ("The Nobel Book of Answers").
