She presented these results at the Homoeopathy Research Institute Conference in London in 2019. Research is a priority and Gabrielle continues to meet and collaborate with her peers in organic groups of homoeopaths, educators and academics.

She currently is the president of the local AHA Victoria branch.

For Gabrielle the intention is to support, protect, promote, verify and emancipate the healing art of homoeopathy in Australia – in harmony with other homoeopathic practitioners. Coming and working together in Australia and being part of an international community has been the driving force for much of her activities.
