

Dr Isaac Golden Ph.D, D.Hom., N.D., B.Ec(Hon)

Isaac Golden has been a homoeopathic practitioner since 1984, and teacher since 1988. In clinic he has specialised in providing immunisation options for parents, and in the treatment of vaccine injured children. He founded the Australasian College of Hahnemannian Homoeopathy in 1990, which offers a variety of courses in homoeopathy. Isaac is a regular contributor to local and international academic journals and is the author of eleven books on homoeopathy. He has lectured in 12 countries.

In March 1999 he was awarded the AHA's Distinguished Service Award for his 'many years of service to the Australian Homoeopathic Association and for his significant contributions to the homoeopathic profession in Australia'.

He is a world authority on homoeoprophylaxis and was the first person to be awarded a PhD from a mainstream Australian university for homoeopathic research. In 2008 he was invited to Cuba and subsequently worked at the Finlay Institute in 2010, 2012 and 2014. From 2015 he visited India five times and worked with members of the Central Council for Research in Homeopathy and the Government of Kerala. He is presently undertaking a range of research projects in Australia and overseas.

He was an Honorary Research Fellow, Faculty of Science, Federation University Australia from 2013 to 2016. He is currently Deputy Chair of the National Institute of Integrative Medicine Ethics Committee and is a research consultant. He is the Australian contact person for Liga Medicorum Homoeopathic Internationalis (LMHI). He co-founded the Health Australia Party in July 2015.
