Dr Sujata Naik with over 30 years clinical experience, has an extensive practice across Mumbai. She has run a charitable outpatient department with her team at a rural hospital in Maharashtra for more than 10 years. A prolific writer, columnist, and orator, she is regularly invited on various health forums to share the benefits of homoeopathy. Her passion is to make homoeopathy a popular mainstream medicine. Her rural-based research has won several international awards, the latest being for *Homeopathy for oral candidiasis following cytotoxic therapy* at the Integrative Oncology Conference, Kochi, February 2020.

She is the first international affiliate member of the Faculty of Homeopathy, UK, and invited to hold clinical sessions for GP's and homoeopaths on various topics including *Homeopathy for Cervical Spondylosis and Psoriasis*. She also presented *Homoeopathic treatment of chronic bronchial asthma in community setup* at LMHI 2019, Sorrento, Italy. She has presented a retrospective study on resistant tinea, carried out at the rural hospital, at both LMHI 2018, Capetown, and the Faculty of Homoeopathy Congress 2018, Liverpool. She was awarded the 1st place for her research poster at the 1st International Conference on Alternative Medicine (AYUSH) in November 2017 at Dubai. Apart from leading her Mumbai Homoeopathy Clinic, she organised more than 20 webinars during the Covid lockdown for homoeopathy students and practitioners.
